## Tuition Assistance Program

### Our Commitment

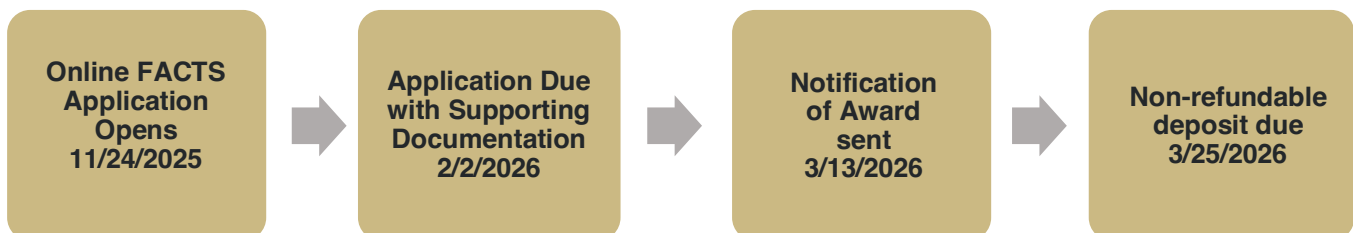
- AMHS is committed to ensuring that all qualified students have the opportunity to attend AMHS, regardless of financial resources.
- Tuition assistance is available to families who demonstrate financial need.
- All applications and awards are confidential and do not influence admissions decisions.

### How It Works

- Tuition assistance is based on a comprehensive review of each family's demonstrated financial need.
- AMHS partners with FACTS, an independent financial need analysis service company (widely used among South Bay Catholic high schools) to process all applications.
- Considerations include: household income and expenses, housing status, number of children in the family, tuition obligations, caregiving responsibilities, etc.

### Important Details & Timeline

All families must **reapply each year** for aid eligibility. A completed FACTS application, including 2024 tax returns and 2025 W-2s, must be submitted by **February 2, 2026**.



# Frequently Asked Questions

## How much tuition assistance does AMHS provide?

- For the 2025-2026 school year, AMHS has awarded approximately **\$7.3 million** in tuition assistance to more than **26%** of the student body.
- The average award was approximately **\$16,000**.

## Do I need to reapply if I received tuition assistance last year?

- Yes. All families must reapply each year to be considered for tuition assistance.

## Is the \$1,500 deposit refundable?

- No. The \$1,500 deposit is **non-refundable**.

## Is financial aid the same as tuition assistance?

- Yes, these terms are used interchangeably.

## Can only one parent in the household apply for tuition assistance?

- No, both parents need to apply for tuition assistance. When completing your tuition assistance application, please ensure that you include your spouse/ or partner and report your combined household income.
- The application also provides an additional comments section, which you may use to share any special circumstances or context that may be helpful in reviewing your request.

## How do single parents apply for tuition assistance?

Please note that, under our policy, single parents—whether remarried or not—are generally assessed at a 50% need level. Archbishop Mitty High School assumes that both parental households contribute toward the student's tuition.

- For students with two living parents, tuition assistance applications will only be reviewed for up to 50% of the total tuition amount for each parent.
- For 100% tuition amount, each parent is required to complete a separate Tuition Assistance Application.
- All financial information provided is kept strictly confidential between households.
- If the other parent does not have contact with the student or is not involved in their life, please note this clearly in the additional comments section of your application. You may be asked to provide documentation to support this information.
